Health Systems Strengthening – Work-plan 2016-17

Further Action on existing work areas/projects:

- i. Strengthening of Laboratory Services:**
 - Developing draft scheme for Free Diagnostics for Chhattisgarh
 - Training of 67 Lab Technicians from 8 tribal districts - Bastar, Dantewada, Narayanpur, Bijapur, Sukma, Jashpur, Surajpur & Balrampur
 - Follow-up visits in above districts
 - Performance monitoring reports on labs
 - External quality assessment and certification of model labs in Surguja and Kondagaon districts

- ii. Free Drug scheme:**
 - Evaluation of implementation of Free Generic Drug policy in Chhattisgarh

- iii. Standard Treatment Guidelines:**
 - Finalisation of Pediatric and Obstetric STGs
 - Developing STG for Sickle-cell anemia

- iv. Hospital Safety:**
 - Preparation of Hospital Safety plans for 29 facilities (district hospitals/medical college hospitals)
 - Training through skill-sessions - Triage, Evacuation, Use of Fire Extinguisher, BLS basics (CPR on dummy)

- v. Biomedical waste management:**
 - In additions to 8 facilities taken-up earlier as model-facilities for Biomedical waste management, another 12 facilities will be developed as model facilities in 2016-17. These facilities will be taken from Surguja and Kondagaon district.

- vi. RMA training:**
 - Training of remaining 120 RMAs in existing 10 day module training
 - Need assessment for next round of training for RMAs
 - Module development for next round of training for RMAs

- vii. AYUSH doctors training:**
 - Capacity building of 60 more AYUSH medical officers on national health programmes

- viii. TB-Nutrition Supplementation Programme:**
 - Completion of Pilot in two districts
 - Support to directorate in formulating state-wide scheme and its roll-out

- ix. Sickle cell anemia**
 - Support to directorate in formulating detailed guidelines (subject to consensus on overall sickle-cell policy draft shared earlier)
- x. Ayurved-gram**
 - Follow-up on recommendations emerging from evaluation of Ayurved-gram
- xi. Maternal health**
 - Follow-up on recommendations emerging from studies currently in progress on Maternal health
- xii. Data Analytics:**
 - Analysis of data on Disease control programmes on Malaria, TB, Leprosy
 - Developing district capacity to analyse HMIS reports and provide feedback to blocks

New activities planned for Health Systems Strengthening:

- xiii. TB:**

Studies/pilot projects on TB in collaboration with ICMR (National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis) and the Central TB division:

 - Study and pilot project on Family member as DOTS provider to prevent treatment interruptions and default especially in tribal, slum populations and hard to reach areas in Chhattisgarh
 - Study and Pilot project on Intensified specimen collection of Gastric aspirates to improve tuberculosis diagnosis in suspected children for tuberculosis in Chhattisgarh. As a part of the study, 27 medical officers and 319 nurses will be trained in taking Gastric lavage from suspected Child TB cases. This will also help in operationalising CBNAAT based testing in the state.

 - HR Planning (including capacity enhancement plan for existing HR) for a tribal district (starting from Kondagaon)
 - Analysis of RMAs playing the role of de-facto in-charge of PHCs and Strategy for career progression for RMAs
 - Study on 'ASHA to ANM: Challenges and Opportunities' in collaboration with NHSRC
