Case #1

A 55 years old male has presented with c/o shortness of breath for past 2-3 months.

O/E BP 184/110 mm Hg. PR-100, pedal oedema present.

Chest having crepts.

What to do

Case#2

A 84years female has come to you for weakness and fatigability.

And history of dizziness

Her BP is 174/64 mm Hg

What will you do?

Case#3

A 24 years old male 5'6" (165cms), weight 78kgs has presented with h/o burning in micturition for past 10 days with fever.

His BS(Random) was 256 mg/dl.

How will you treat this patient?

What investigations will you advise him?

Case#4

A 66 years male with height 5'7" has complaints of frequency of micturition and weakness has presented to you.

He is having random sugar of 250mg/dl

How will you manage this case?

Case #5

- A 70 years old diabetic patient has presented to you with unconsciousness for past one hour.
- O/E he has up-going planters on right side.
- How will you approach this case

Case#6

- A 45 years farmer has presented with complaints of heaviness in chest for past 20 minutes.
- He also has one vomiting few minutes back
- How will you treat this patient

Case#7

- A 55 yrs male smoker with history of chronic cough has presented with increased shortness of breath for past 5 days with fever.
- He has bilateral ronchi on auscultation.
- How will you manage this case?
