

Availability of Essential Drugs – Assessment Report

Status on 28th December 2019

Objectives: This assessment is meant to answer the following questions:

- a) What proportion of important drugs are available in CGMSC godowns and whether their stock is adequate to cover the buffer quantity
- b) If some important drugs are not adequately available with CGMSC, whether facilities are able to provide them through local purchase
- c) If certain important drugs are in shortage, what should be the next steps at CGMSC and facility level to improve availability

Methods: In order to assess the availability of much needed essential drugs, this analysis focuses on a list of 144 high priority drugs. These fast moving drugs are frequently prescribed by physicians and cover a large share of primary health care needs of the population. This list has been officially designated as ‘fast moving’ drugs by Directorate of Health Services. Of these fast moving drugs, 122 are for primary care use and the remaining 22 can be used at CHC and above. For this analysis, data on stocks in godowns and facilities, purchase orders and rate contracts has been taken from CGMSC website on 28th December 2019 and compared with 3 month buffer quantities defined by Directorate of Health Services. Current stock quantity in godowns includes the quantity under Quality Control (QC).

A. Status at CGMSC Level:

Table-1 shows that 96 of the high-priority drugs are in severe shortage out of which 61 are completely stocked-out. Situation is likely to improve for 44 such drugs as CGMSC has placed Purchase Orders for them. That leaves 52 drugs in severe shortage, out of which 48 do not have rate contract.

Overall 144 fast moving drugs, 56 drugs do not have rate contract. Some examples of drugs without live rate contract are - Inj. Magnesium Sulphate, Permethrin Lotion, Tab. Enalapril, Tab. Cetrizine, Tab Diclofenac Sodium , Glucometer test strips etc.

The following 4 drugs however can be ordered as rate contracts exist for them:

Annexure 1 provides number of stock out drugs according to Universal (U), Primary (P), Secondary (S) and Tertiary (T) categories of drugs. List of drugs which have stock out is given in **Annexure 2** and list of stock out drugs with no live rate contract in **Annexure 3**. List of drugs for which POs have been issued but stocks are yet to be received, is given in **Annexure 4**.

B. Status at Facility Level:

If some drugs are in shortage at CGMSC level, are facilities able to arrange them through local purchase? In order to assess this, 4 of the important drugs were taken as availability was checked for 5 sample districts.

Table-2 below shows that these drugs were stocked-out in most of PHCs and CHCs. Some drugs were absent even in District Hospitals. However, there is a chance that facilities have the stocks but have not entered the local purchase stock in software.

c. Suggested Next Steps:

- 1. Focus – CGMSC should focus on 144 drugs designated by DHS as fast-moving drugs**
- 2. Fresh Rate Contracts – 56 drugs out of the 144 do not have rate contracts and getting rate contracts for them should be a priority.**
- 3. Local purchase as short term measure – Districts should focus their local purchase on the 48 drugs in severe shortage.**
- 4. Completing Local Purchase entries by districts/facilities**
- 5. Physical verification of local purchase and facility stocks**
